- b) Library News & Programs: Northwoods Book Festival (a group of 7 area libraries including PICL) was awarded a grant of \$10,000 (from a highly competetive field). The theme is "Open Books, Open Minds" with an emphasis on local Multicultural authors.

- d) For the month of February, there will be a new Youth Art Show on display.
